

SID MALLORY 2010 RECIPIENT OF *Si Seymour Award* from The Association for Healthcare Philanthropy

Sid Mallory, MBA, FAHP, of Henderson Mallory Partners was the 2010 recipient of the Association for Healthcare Philanthropy's *Si Seymour Award*. The award, which has been presented annually since 1970, honors a fundraising professional whose career "reflects exemplary standards of excellence in fostering volunteerism and philanthropy," according to AHP.

Mallory, one of the principals in Henderson Mallory Partners, was selected for the award because of his "unstinting support of quality health care for American Communities," according to William C. McGinly, president and CEO of AHP.
